Toilet Training


Potty training is a key developmental milestone. It's vital that parents and practitioners work together to give children consistent messages. We are able to achieve this only when the child is ready and able to say and show signs of readiness. Being toilet trained is a skill that children need to develop independence, self-esteem and confidence to thrive at school. Ofsted guidelines state that 'Every child should be able to go to the toilet independently by the age of five.'

We will help and support your child as long as they know and understand some common words, able to pull up and down their clothing or ask for the toilet. We remind them constantly and take them to the toilet but we have a lot of children here and everyone is busy whether they are staff or children playing. So please excuse the accidents that can occasionally happen.
